Dear Sisters,

Our Sisters have opened and received in their convents in Western Ukraine, Poland and Croatia around 90 persons. Most of them are women and children.

They provide for them shelter, food and all other necessary things for living. The refugees are from different parts of Ukraine. Mostly from Eastern and Central Ukraine.

Our communities in Croatia have also received 12 persons in their house. Mothers and children are mainly from the Western part of Ukraine who fleed after the first shelling in that area. They live with Sisters, our communities provide for them shelter, food and all necessary things. Those women and children usually participate in the prayers of the community, especially in Liturgy on Sundays.

Thank you for your loving support. We and those who are suffering appreciate your help. It allows us to cover the expenses of living for those who most of the times do not have a place where to return.
