Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The song of the angels at Christmas to the shepherds of long ago and to us today: Glory to God in the highest! and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests Luke 2.14. For Francis of Assisi, Christmas was the ultimate reminder of how much God loved us, to come to us, to become one of us and show us the way to be truly human. The Incarnation is the true compassion of God that Francis perceived so clearly.

Let us live this, not only as a moment in spiritual history, but as the eternal insertion of God, an ever-deepening penetration of love, in our sacred history. We are part of the Incarnation in our world, God-with-us in our time. As Franciscans, we have chosen to follow in the footprints of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, who gave his life for the very things our world is most in need of now: human community/solidarity, love and compassion for our brothers and sisters, earnest searching for the truth and doing God’s work. May our choices echo the song of the angels long ago that peace and love dwell in our world in the lives of all good people. Glory to God in the highest!
